Joshua Pison Masaba serves as artist-in-residence and director of the Department for African Arts and Crafts Design at the Foundation for Development of Needy Communities (FDNC) in Uganda. Under his supervision, students and other local artists create a wide range of traditional craft items and market them with FDNC's assistance, providing a sustainable livelihood for the artists.

FDNC was founded in 1996 to promote the productivity, creativity, and self-reliance of women, youth, and children. FDNC works with others to promote social justice and develop sustainable livelihoods within vulnerable communities.

Since 2000, Church World Service has partnered with FDNC to support community-based opportunities for young girls, among the most vulnerable members of Ugandan society. Programs include education and vocational training, as well as livestock to provide food security and a source of income.
