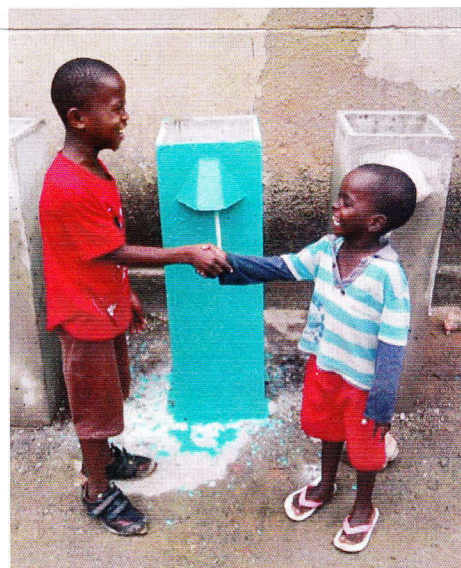
*Just two hours of sponsored naps can provide clean water for an orphanage, school, or family for up to 30 years!*



At the Kigezi Orphans Home in far southwestern Kenya, 400 children lacked access to *any* clean drinking water. They regularly suffered from waterborne illnesses – typhoid, bacterial dysentery, Rotavirus, cryptosporidium, and, occasionally, cholera. Child mortality is very high, and there are no doctors. In September 2013, **Friendly Water for the World's** Uganda Representative installed two BioSand Water Filters.

Three weeks later, Orphans Home Director Julius Katemba wrote us: **"It's a miracle! Among the 400 children, there is no dysentery, no diarrhea, not even a single stomach ache!"** We hope later to return to the community to teach them how to build more Filters themselves.

Based in Olympia, Washington, **Friendly Water for the World** is a non-profit 50(c)(3) organization that teaches communities around the world ways to ensure their own clean drinking water supply through community sanitation, hygiene, and fabricating and installing BioSand Water Filters. BioSand Water Filters are a simple, affordable, household technology, made with all local materials, which can remove up to 95-99% of bacteria and viruses, and 100% of worms, parasites, amoebae, protozoa, as well as some metals. They work for up to 30 years with very little maintenance. Currently, there are **Friendly Water for the World** projects in Kenya, India, Burundi, Afghanistan, Ethiopia, Uganda, Burundi, DRC-Congo, Zimbabwe, and Honduras. Training programs are also held in North America for individuals, missions, Peace Corps volunteers, and churches who want to help communities ensure safe drinking water.
